- Green Fleet Review

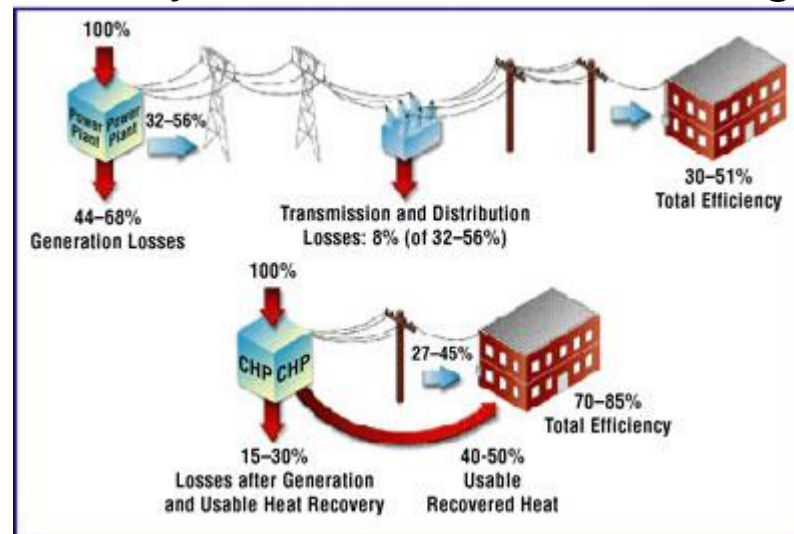
Achievements continued
