

## **MINUTES OF THE LICENSING SUB-COMMITTEE**

**22 MARCH 2011**

### **81/11 APPLICATION BY PRECIOUS LINK (UK) LTD. FOR A PREMISES LICENCE AT 21 SHEPPERTON ROAD, LALEHAM – TO CONSIDER REPRESENTATIONS IN RESPECT OF THE APPLICATION**

The Chairman introduced members and officers present and welcomed everyone to the meeting. He then explained the procedure to be followed at the meeting.

The Licensing Manager outlined the application which had been set out in the Report of the Head of Environmental Health and Building Control Services.

The Principal Solicitor advised the Sub-Committee that the applicant had agreed to the conditions requested by Surrey Police, a responsible authority and that as a result the police had withdrawn their representation prior to this hearing.

Thirteen representations had been received from interested parties living in the vicinity. One of these had been omitted from the agenda papers and was circulated to all parties for consideration. The applicant agreed that an adjournment was not necessary to consider this representation and that they were happy to proceed with the hearing.

In summary the representations concerned the potential for:

- an increase in crime, disorder and anti social behaviour
- an increase in public nuisance – noise and litter
- underage sales

The Sub-Committee then proceeded to hear the matter in accordance with the adopted rules and procedure.

The Sub-Committee retired to consider and determine the application, having regard to the relevant licensing objectives.

Upon reconvening, the Chairman announced the Sub-Committee's decision. The Sub-Committee had considered all the relevant evidence made available to it and in doing so had taken into account the regulations issued under the Licensing Act 2003, National Guidance and Spelthorne Borough Council's Statement of Licensing Policy.

The Chairman then read the decision of the Sub-Committee which would be included as part of the Decision Notice and appended to these Minutes.

**RESOLVED** that the application by precious Link (UK) Ltd for a premises licence in respect of 21 Shepperton Road, Laleham be granted subject to modification by addition of conditions and amendment of licensable hours, as set out in full in the attached Decision Notice.
