**327/10 APPLICATION BY SUNG CHUL LIM FOR A PREMISES LICENCE
IN RESPECT OF FOREST AND OCEAN, 13-15 HIGH STREET,
MARKET SQUARE, STAINES - TO CONSIDER
REPRESENTATIONS IN RESPECT OF THE APPLICATION.**

The Chairman introduced members and officers present and welcomed the applicant Mr Sung Chul Lim and his agent, Christopher Grunert and the interested parties to the meeting.

The Licensing Manager outlined details of the application which had been set out in the Report of the Head of Environmental Health and Building Control Services.

Twelve letters of representation had been received from residents living in the vicinity relating to the licensing objectives of the prevention of crime and disorder and the prevention of public nuisance. In summary, the objections concerned drunken behaviour, noise and litter.

The Sub-Committee proceeded to hear the matter in accordance with the adopted rules and procedure.

The Sub-Committee retired to consider and determine the application, having regard to the licensing objectives on the prevention of public nuisance and prevention of crime and disorder.

Upon reconvening, the Chairman announced the Sub-Committee's decision.

The Chairman informed the applicant and interested parties that they would be sent a written copy of the Sub-Committee's decision with reasons, within five working days.

RESOLVED that the application by Sung Chul Lim for a Premises Licence in respect of Forest and Ocean, 13-15 High Street, Market Square, Staines be refused for the reasons set out in the attached Decision Notice.
