254/11 **APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE BY HARPARIT SINGH IN RESPECT OF JUST 4U, 117 GROVELEY ROAD, SUNBURY TW16 7JZ**

The Chairman introduced members and officers present and welcomed everyone to the meeting. He asked the applicant and his representatives and the responsible authorities present to introduce themselves. He then explained the procedure to be followed at the meeting.

The Licensing Manager outlined the application which had been set out in the Report of the Head of Environmental Health and Building Control Services.

Representations had been received from two responsible authorities: Surrey Police and Surrey Trading Standards. In summary the representations concerned the troubled history of the premises in relation to:

- crime, disorder and anti social behaviour and
- underage sales

The Sub-Committee proceeded to hear the matter in accordance with the adopted rules and procedure.

At the conclusion of closing submissions from the responsible authorities, Mr Petts, Counsel for the applicant, requested a short adjournment in order to consult with his client.

RESOLVED to adjourn the hearing to allow Mr Petts, Counsel for the applicant, to consult with his client, Mr Harparit Singh.

The meeting reconvened and Mr Petts presented his closing submission on behalf of the applicant.

Having heard the evidence presented, the Sub-Committee retired to consider and determine the application, having regard to the four licensing objectives.

Upon reconvening, the Chairman gave the Sub-Committee's summary decision.

The full decision with reasons would be notified to the applicant and responsible authorities within five working days of the hearing.

RESOLVED that the premises licence in respect of Just 4U, 117 Groveley Road, Sunbury be granted subject to modification by addition of conditions, as set out in full in the attached Decision Notice.
