Elmsleigh expanding future

There are exciting new plans for the next stage of development at the Elmsleigh Centre in Staines.

Plans have been submitted for the southern side of the Centre with improvements to the Bus Station and the creation of nearly 50,000 sq ft of retail space on two floors plus a third floor over the BHS building. If approved by the Council's Planning Committee, work could begin as early as autumn this year with potential opening in Easter 2012.

As well as additional retail space, there will be improved views from South Street. Benefits include:

- extension of the South Mall to the same high quality as the other malls
- creation of a new southern entrance
- a newly designed and organised Bus Station with a café and a secure covered waiting area with facilities for bus crews
- re-arranged pavements and features in the immediate surrounding area of the new extension
- creation of a temporary Bus Station on the Elmsleigh surface car park which will enable the work to continue alongside bus services
