How do I install and maintain the Cone?

The Green Cone needs to be installed in a sunny part of your garden. The digestion chamber needs to be buried in the garden by digging a hole (up to 90cm wide by 70cm deep). It is vital to install the green cone in an area of good drainage – or to create good drainage by putting gravel under the digestion chamber.

Under no circumstances must the base or the digestion chamber be below the water table and where water gathers.

Once the Green Cone is properly installed (full installation instructions are supplied with the Green Cone) it will work with very little maintenance.

Where should I locate a Green Johanna?

Ideally as close to the kitchen as possible as you may want to put food waste in up to four times a week. The composter should stand on soil or grass, so that worms can get through the holes in the base. A good place is in the shade.

How much kitchen waste will it take?

Around 120 kilos per person per year.

What are the dimensions of a Green Cone and Green Johanna?

Green Cone – height (above ground) 70cm; depth (below ground) 42cm; diameter of lid 28cm; diameter (top of basket) 59cm. **Green Johanna** – height 94cm; diameter of lid 53cm; diameter of base 81cm.
