

## **Article 15 – Review and Revision of the Constitution**

### **15.1 Duty to monitor and review the constitution**

The Monitoring Officer and the Standards Committee will monitor and review the operation of the Constitution to ensure that the aims and principles of the Constitution are given full effect.

### **15.2 Changes to the Constitution**

- (a) Changes to the constitution will only be approved by the full Council after considering a report on the proposal by the Monitoring Officer and any advice from the Standards Committee.
- (b) Any councillor, any Committee or the Executive may submit proposals for changes to this Constitution to the Council for consideration.
- (c) The Council must take reasonable steps to consult with local electors and other interested persons in the area when drawing up proposals to change from a leader and cabinet form of Executive to alternative arrangements.
