The DPD and Core Strategy fail to provide a sufficient degree of flexibility to allow for a potential shortfall in the amount of land available to serve the needs of Heathrow Airport, particularly off airport car parking in close proximity to the Airport and with good access thereto. This form is also deficient in that it fails to allow for the possibility of a plan being sent with it to explain the location of the land concerned. It also fails to allow the local planning authority to know where the site referred to is. The land in respect of which this representation is made lies to east of Stanwell Moor Road.
