SYTC is a theatre club for budding young performers with a passion for creating drama. It runs during term time at Stanwell Youth Centre and is for children aged 8-11yrs and young people aged 12-15yrs.

Led by professional Drama Artists, SYTC is a vibrant drama club where the children are in control! Together the company write, devise and create fresh new theatre which will be performed at various events throughout the borough.

Children can develop confidence, acting skills, directing, and writing or production techniques. Performances are devised by the group through drama exercises, improvisation, writing techniques, music and choreography. Each member of SYTC is equally important in producing each performance.

SYTC costs differ depending on the number of weeks during a term but for a 14 week term it is £58.80. Booking is essential as a waiting list may apply.

P&G Surrey Youth Games

The P & G Surrey Youth Games, held annually in June, is the largest youth sports festival in Surrey. Around 2,500 young people from across Surrey participate in the games each year with many more being involved in coaching sessions in the lead up to the event. The Surrey Youth Games, sponsored by Proctor and Gamble have been held annually for the last 15 years. In 2011 Spelthorne entered 21 teams across 11 sports with around 300 children and young people being involved.

In the run up to the games, children and young people aged 7–16 receive between 4 and 9 weeks coaching in their chosen sport or sports. These sessions begin in April and are held at various venues throughout the borough. There are many sports to choose from including hockey, netball, squash, badminton and judo. Beginners are welcome and it is a great opportunity to try out a new sport or improve existing skills.

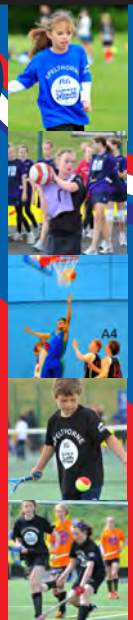
