**LOCAL GOVERNMENT FINANCE ACT, 1988**  
(FOR INFORMATION)

**SECTION 43** provides that a charity (or trustees for a charity) occupying a premises for charitable purposes is entitled to mandatory rate relief of 80%

**SECTION 47** provides that a charity accepted as being eligible for relief under Section 43 may apply to the charging authority for further relief. The granting of such relief (if any) is at the discretion of the Council up to a maximum of 20% thus bringing the relief up to 100%
