Trial at Heathrow to explore the potential to reduce delays and late running flights

A trial has started at Heathrow to explore if the runways and the airspace around the airport can be used in a more efficient and flexible way to help cut delays and reduce the number of late running flights.

The trial will take place in two phases. The first started on 1 November 2011 and will run to 29 February 2012, the second from 1 July 2012 to 30 September 2012.

This trial is a recommendation of the Government's South East Airport Taskforce which was set up in 2010 to look at how to make London's airports 'better, not bigger'. This trial will not mean an increase in the number of flights operating in or out of Heathrow.

The conditions under which the procedures can be used have been agreed with the Department for Transport and the Civil Aviation Authority.
