

**Traditional Graves** - may be planted along the full length, and headstones and kerbs can be installed. Grave owners must maintain planted areas or the area inside the kerbs to comply with Cemetery regulations.

**Lawn Sections** - Kerbstones or full-length gardens are not allowed, and all planting is to be kept within 12 inches of the memorial. The placing of markers, fencing, gravel, chippings or glass containers cannot be allowed and may be removed.

**Cremated Remains Plots** - Memorial Plaques, tablets and memorial vases only are allowed in the Gardens of Remembrance. Each plot can hold up to two sets of Cremated Remains with the tablet covering the whole plot or with the plaque being positioned over the centre of the whole area. Any objects or materials placed on the plots may be removed by Cemetery staff as these are not permitted.

**Memorial Maintenance** - It is recommended that all memorials should be insured against theft, loss or damage. The Grant owner is responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of the memorial, and any other items placed on the grave.

All memorials must be fixed to meet the standards set out in NAMM's Code of Working Practice

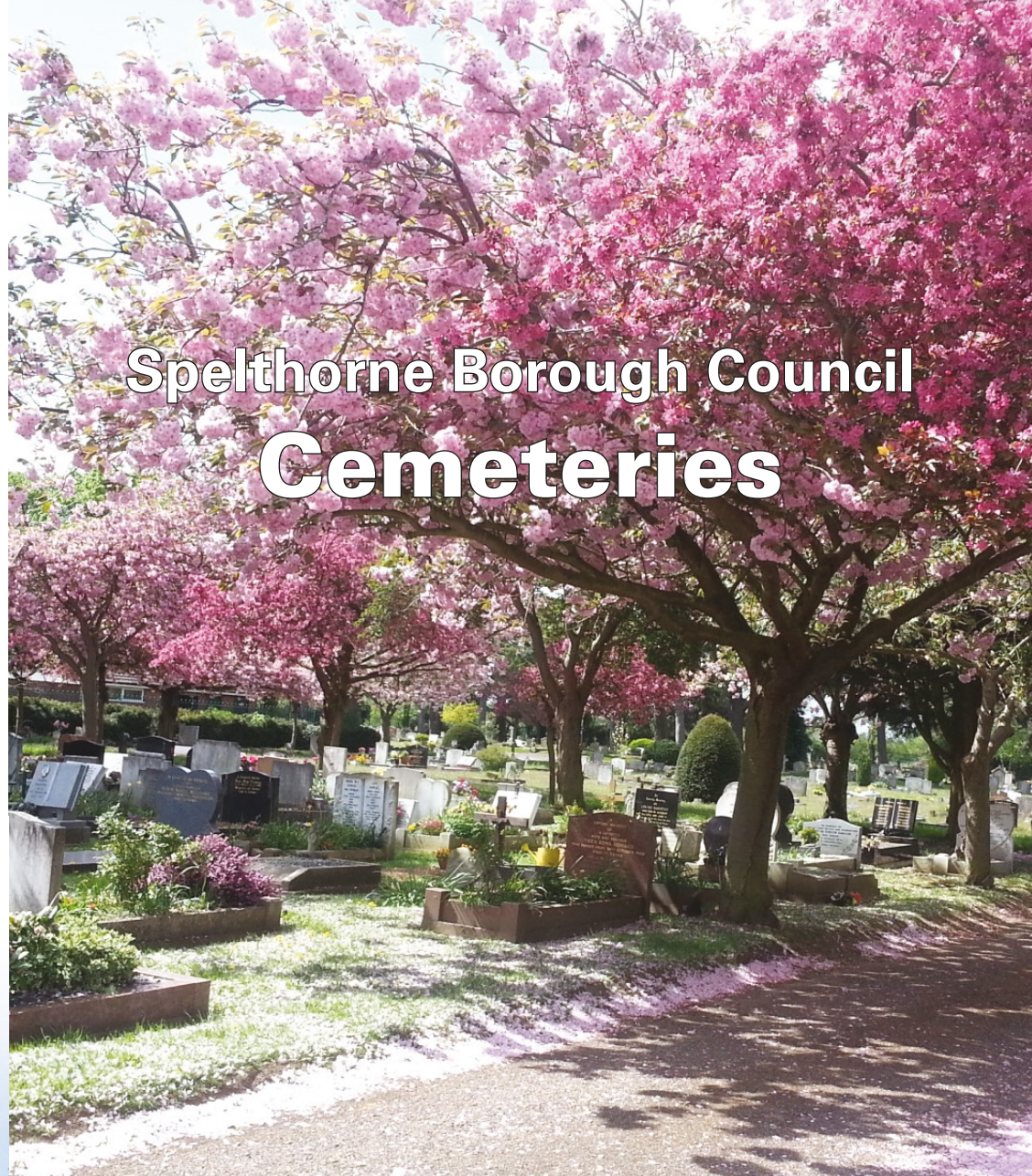
## 24 Hour Burial Section
