M Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General - all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 9)

The premises will operate as a warehouse and dispatch facility for both wholesale supply to pubs and restaurants (in line with our AWRS registration) and retail sales fulfilled exclusively through Amazon.co.uk. For retail sales, Amazon applies strict age verification controls, including customer age checks at account setup, restrictions preventing under-18s from ordering alcohol, and the Challenge 25 policy at delivery. For wholesale supply, we maintain full due diligence checks on trade customers as required under the AWRS. The premises will continue to be managed responsibly to ensure compliance with all relevant licensing laws, health and safety regulations, and fire safety requirements. Procedures are in place to prevent crime and disorder, ensure public safety, minimise any risk of nuisance to neighbours, and protect children from harm.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

Alcohol will only be sold in sealed containers and dispatched via approved couriers. No sales will take place face-to-face on the premises. AWRS procedures are in place for wholesale supply. Records of all sales will be retained and made available to authorities upon request.

c) Public safety

The premises is a warehouse used for storage and dispatch only. No members of the public will have access. Health and safety policies are in place for staff handling. Alcohol is securely stored, and the premises is alarmed and monitored.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

No customers will visit the premises and there will be no on-site sales or consumption of alcohol. All sales are either wholesale to other business or online, and alcohol will be dispatched in sealed packaging. Courier collections will normally take place during standard delivery hours, but the premises requires flexibility for collections outside these hours to meet operational needs. Strict measures will be in place to ensure that any collections outside standard hours do not cause noise, litter, or disturbance to local residents.

e) The protection of children from harm

Age verification procedures are in place for all online retail sales which will take place through Amazon.co.uk. Amazon operates strict age-restriction policies to ensure alcohol cannot be ordered by under-18s, and applies the Challenge 25 principle at delivery. Deliveries are refused if valid proof of age is not provided. For wholesale supply, full AWRS due diligence checks are carried out on all trade customers to ensure alcohol is only supplied to legitimate licensed businesses. In addition, no under-18s will be permitted to work unsupervised in the storage or dispatch areas of the premises. Training records will be maintained for all staff involved in the handling of alcohol orders.
