

1. Introduction

- 1.1 This document sets out data from the 2011 Census for Spelthorne, adjoining boroughs and the rest of Surrey. Where appropriate comparison is also made with data from the 2001 Census.
- 1.2 It incorporates information on the census published by the Council in July 2012 in 'Fact Sheet No 1' which provided initial population totals.
- 1.3 This current document will be updated as new data is published.

2. Background

- 2.1 On 27 March 2011 the Government undertook a census of the United Kingdom. The first results were published by the Office for National Statistics (ONS) on 16 July 2012. Detailed information at local authority level was published at the end of November 2012. Ward level data is expected to be published at the end of January 2013 and further releases are expected throughout the rest of 2013.

3. Population

Total Population and Age Profiles

- 3.1 Overall there has been a 7.7% growth in the population of England and Wales from 2001 to 2011. Spelthorne's population growth of 5.8% is below this average. In the adjoining authorities population change varies from 3.2% in Runnymede to 17.7% in Slough.
- 3.2 Table 1 shows Spelthorne's population in the national and regional context. Table 2 compares Spelthorne's population change with adjoining authorities and the rest of the Surrey.

3.3 Table 3 shows the population age profile for Spelthorne. It shows that within a total population growth of over 5,000 in 10 years there has been a slight fall in the 25-44 age group but a 14.7% rise in the 45-64 age group. There has been a significant percentage rise in the 85+ age group.

3.11 Table 11 shows the ethnic groups to which the population in Spelthorne and surrounding areas belong. This shows 81% of Spelthorne's population as 'White British', which is higher than any of the other adjoining authorities. In Spelthorne 4.2% of the population is Indian, which is the highest percentage in Surrey but lower than most other adjoining authorities. Of the 1.6% recorded as 'Black' 1.0% is 'Black African'.
